

Borrowing other Evergreen materials

As part of the Evergreen Indiana Consortium, additional materials are available to borrow from over 120 other libraries. Either visit the Library owning the desired materials or request the items to be delivered to the Butler Public Library by placing a hold on the item.

Items available for trans-it includes books, audiobooks, magazines, music cd's and selected DVDs/Blu-rays with the following exceptions:

- Items added to a library's collection during the last 6 months
- Movies not designated as holdable by other Evergreen patrons regardless of when the item was added to the collection.

Items checkout at other Evergreen libraries may be returned to the Butler Public Library for delivery back to the owning library except items specifically noted at checkout by the Evergreen Library.

Local Evergreen Libraries include: Waterloo-Grant Township Public Library, Eckhart Public Library, Garrett Public Library, Carnegie Public Library of Steuben County and Noble County Public Library.



Student Cards are not eligible for this service. Student cards are restricted to items owned by the Butler Public Library.
