



Household Borrowing Policy

Members of a household, living at the same address, will be linked together in the library's circulation system.

Any household member whose account reaches \$10.00 will affect the entire group's ability to checkout items and to have internet access.

- Adult members will lose library privileges including but not limited to: borrowing library materials and equipment, using the public computers, accessing the public Wi-Fi or utilizing the Community Room.
- Children will have limited library privileges. Children may continue to have internet access for homework only and to check out age appropriate books but will not be able to borrow movies or video games.

All library privileges to all household members will be reinstated once the fines have been reduced below the \$10.00 threshold.
