Household Borrowing Policy

Members of a household living at the same address will be linked together in the library's circulation system and will be responsible for each other's fine and fees above \$10.00. Responsible adults will lose library privileges until their children's fines and fees are under the \$10.00 threshold. Privileges lost include but are not limited to: borrowing library materials and equipment; computer and Internet use and use of the Community Room.

Children may have limited library privileges if an adult household member has exceeded a library account balance of \$10.00. The children may continue to check out books and use the computer for homework but will not be able to borrow DVD's and electronic games.
