

How can I get a **Library Card**?



Full Evergreen Access Library Card The “**GREEN**” Card

Residents of the City of Butler may receive a library card at no additional cost because library services are funded by their property taxes.

- Proof of residency must be provided when applying for a card, along with an Indiana state issued ID
- Additionally, a parent/guardian must sign the application of an individual under the age of 18 assuming responsibility for the account.

Non-Residents, those individuals that live outside the city limits of Butler, must purchase an annual subscription. The cost of a subscription is based on the average cost a resident of the City of Butler pays for library services through their property taxes.

- Current subscription rates are available under the “Non-Resident Fees” tab.
- Semi-annual and quarterly subscription options are also available.



Limited Access Library Card The “**BLUE**” Card

Students living in the DeKalb Eastern School District or attending a DeKalb Eastern School may apply for a free library card as a courtesy of the Butler Public Library Board of Trustees.

- Only the student in whose name the card has been issued may use the card.
- Checkout restrictions apply.
- A parent/guardian must sign the application of a student under the age of 18 assuming responsibility for the account.
